


Jillian Michaels

[MUST-READ REPORT]

HE SCARY TRUTH



he biggest star on The Biggest Loser, trainer Jillian Michaels, has a secret. On her right shoulder, there's a small black tattoo, written in Japanese, that reveals more about her than she ever intended. She got the ink when she was 16, shortly after she had transformed herself, through martial arts, from a 175-pound "troubled fat kid with acne and braces" to the lean, mean fighting machine we know and love today. The tattoo was supposed to read "Restless Thunder," her black belt name. Instead, she was shocked to discover years later, it says "friend." "That f---er at the tattoo parlor didn't know what he was doing, so he just wrote friend!" she says, laughing. But as it turns out, despite the drill-sergeant image Michaels projects on Loser, the tattoo's sweet sentiment suits her. What you don't see on TV is that, underneath all the bluster, she's a total softie. If you watch the show, it may look as if Michaels is all about driving the contestants to train harder, longer and sweatier, but in fact, she says, her larger goal is to help them understand how their behaviors got them to their overweight, unhappy state in the first place. "I have a good understanding because I've been there," she says. The 35-year-old star (and new SELF contributing editor) is committed to imparting the life lessons she has learned—about losing weight and being true to yourself—to others. Including you.

On authenticity

Though Michaels had been into fitness since her teens, when she was 23, she took a job as a motionpicture packaging agent. "I was miserable. I didn't have any meaning in my life," she recalls. When she left the job and got back into training, "I went to work ecstatic every day." Still, when she was approached for The Biggest Loser, "I didn't want to do it. I didn't like the name of the show," she says. "But I met with NBC. They said, 'We want to try to take 100 pounds off somebody. Can you do that?' I was like, 'Sure. In a year.' And they said, 'We're going to give you these people. You're going to run their lives.' I was like, 'Oh, my God! Complete control?' It was too tempting! Five years later, we're going into Season 8. And they lose the weight in two months." While taping, she spends 14 hours a day, six days a week, with the contestants. "It's nothing like what you see on TV," she says. She let SELF in on what it is like:

Big results take time. "We're in the gym all day and night. The contestants easily do five hours of cardio a day, which I control.

'You, on the stairs! Level 6, no hands! You, on the rowing machine! Thirty-second intervals at 200 meters per second!' And then I'll pull each one down for an hour and a half of hard-core, beat-thecrap-out-of-you training. And in the middle of their trying to lose weight, we're making a television show. So the producers need this one or that one for an interview. Sometimes, I'm like, 'Damn it, you can't have Helen! I haven't worked her out in two days!" A reality show doesn't always show a lot of reality. "Of the 100 hours we shoot for each episode, you see maybe 10 minutes of reality. I always end up looking mean and Bob looks nice. It drives me crazy to be portrayed as one-sided because it makes me look arbitrary, and I'm not. I'm aggressive in the gym, but I also have the ability to be introspective. The contestants will go, 'I didn't like when you said that to me.' And I'll say, 'I'm really sorry. I'll try this approach with you.' I'm passionate about how I do this job, and when that doesn't come across, it breaks my heart because I'm really true to my methods. I can't deny everything the show has allowed me—the platform it has presented to me to get out a bigger message. I think the show does a lot of good in the world. Just personally, it's hard. I'm like, 'This is not what happens!"
